

How to Set the Morphic M14 Series Watch

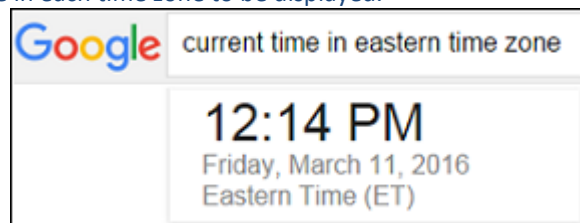
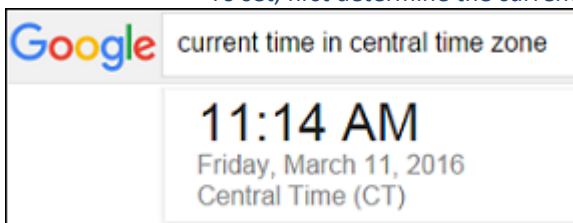
- 1) Pull the crown to its most outward position.
- 2) Set the watch to AM time by rotating the crown counterclockwise till the date indicator changes. *
- 3) Set the current time by rotating the crown counterclockwise. For AM, do not advance the hour hand past the 12 o'clock position - for PM, advance the hour hand past the 12 o'clock position once.
- 4) Push the crown in to its middle position.
- 5) Set the current date by rotating the crown clockwise until the correct value is displayed.
- 6) Set the secondary time zone hand by rotating the crown counterclockwise.
- 7) Return the crown to its most inward position to commence timekeeping.

Secondary Time Zone

The red hand serves as an indicator for a separate time zone that is read in 24 hour time. The primary and secondary time zones are set independently but both advance as the watch runs. The small red numbers and black circles on the outside of the dial are the indicators for the secondary time zone and they are read with approximation. For example, in the image below the secondary time zone is set to 2:30 am.



To set, first determine the current time in each time zone to be displayed.



The watch would then be set as such:
