## The Empress Godiva Timepiece

(EM1101 - EM1107)

Mechanical automatic watches harness the kinetic energy contained within the natural movement of your arm to generate the force required to operate. The watch will commence operation after a sufficient volume of initial power has been generated by handling / wearing or by manually winding the crown. Supplemental winding through wear or manual winding will ensure sustained functionality and increase the duration in which the watch will continue to operate when unworn.



## **Setting Instructions**


- 1) Pull the crown out one click to its most outward position.
- 2) Set the current time by rotating the crown counterclockwise.
- 3) Push the crown in to its rest / manual winding position.
- 4) Manually wind the mainspring by rotating the crown clockwise 10 20 times.

## **Water Resistance Guidelines**

**10 ATM** - short duration and low depth resistance only. Not suitable for extended swimming periods or bathing. Not suitable for diving. **Note:** Manipulation of the crown while the watch is in contact with water will negate the rated water resistance as water penetration may occur.

## **Resizing Instructions** (EM1101 – EM1104 series watches)

**Note:** any cosmetic imperfections or physical damage caused by resizing the bracelet is not warranted by Empress. As such, professional adjustment of the bracelet is recommended.





- 1) Support the bracelet in a bracelet holder.
- 2) Use a 1mm pin punch to drive the link pin out in the direction of the arrow on the underside of the link. figure A
- 3) Remove the pin from the next link to remove one full link.
- 4) Installation is the reverse of removal.
- 5) In place of removing one link, or to fine tune fitment, the clasp link spring bar may be relocated to one of the two alternative mounting locations on the clasp. *figure B*
